# CHICHESTER HARBOUR FEDERATION REGATTA

## Conditions of Entry:

### 1.1 Governing Rules:

The Regatta shall be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, RYA Prescriptions thereto, The Sailing Instructions & Notice of Race, and Class Rules. In the event of conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail. The Race Committee reserves the right to change this Notice of Race prior to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2005. Any rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions, excepting 14 (Protests), as below. The Regatta is a Category 'C' Event under ISAF Advertising Regs.

### 1.2 Good Behaviour:

The Race Committee reserves the right (in addition to Rule 69) to withdraw any competitors entry at any time (without refund of entry fee) for any race or races, if any competitor or competitor's guest is found to have misbehaved either afloat or ashore in any manner unsuitable for a family regatta week, including the use of inappropriate language. This applies whilst attending any Federation Club premises. All competitors will be issued with tamperproof wristbands, which are to be worn for the week, to validate access to H.I.S.C.

### 1.3 Disclaimer of Liability:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither Hayling Island Sailing Club nor Chichester Harbour Federation will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Moreover every owner / competitor warrants the suitability of his yacht for the race or races.

### 1.4 Insurance & Measurement Certificates:

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million pounds per event or the equivalent. Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate.

## 2. Entry Fees:

ADULTS (per boat)	£27 for the series or £10.00 for the day.
JUNIORS* (per boat)	£17 for the series or £6.00 for the day. *(Under 16 on 1.1.05)

Unless already in possession of a Chichester Harbour or Langstone Harbour Plaque an additional charge of £3.50 will be made for the week, or £2.00 for up to 2 days.

## 3. Entries & Sailing Instructions:

Entries will be taken at the Clubhouse at the following times: Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> August 1300hrs – 1700hrs;  
Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> August 1300hrs – 1800hrs;  
Monday 8<sup>th</sup> August 0800hrs onwards.

Early entries may be posted to H.I.S.C. and Sailing Instructions collected from H.I.S.C. office at above times. Competitors must complete all parts of the entry form in a legible manner, and sign the declaration. Any boat that is sailed by a different helm other than that declared on the entry form shall be a separate entry. Owing to the shortage of parking space only one car per entry will be allowed at H.I.S.C.

## 4. Classes (events) to be sailed, Start times, and Number of Races:

These shall be in accordance with The Race Programme shown on the back page of this Notice of Race. Yachts without a Portsmouth Numbers may apply for special permission to enter in events 1, 3, 5, 13 & 19, (excluding skiffs, fox, multihulls etc) The Race Committee may require dinghies to race other than on the published yardstick for that boat.

All classes shall have one race per day, excepting Series 3 Classes which shall have 2 races on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, the second race following completion of the first.

## 5. Location and Courses to be Sailed:

Courses shall be within Chichester Harbour and as set out for each class in their appropriate Series Sailing Instructions.

## 6. Scoring System:

Points shall be awarded in accordance with RRS Appendix A Low Points system, except that the first place shall receive ¾ of a point.

## 7. Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to the helm and crew for each class on a points basis for the best THREE out of FIVE races, (Series 1 & 2), or FIVE out of EIGHT races (Series 3), and according to the declared number of entries in each event on the basis

Three boats to enter or no event

Seven boats to enter ~ 3 prizes

Five boats to enter ~ 2 prizes

For each additional nine entries ~ 1 prize.

## 8. Trophies:

INTERCLUB TROPHIES ~ Any club may nominate to The Race Office prior to Tuesday's (1<sup>st</sup>) race a team of five boats, whose helms are members of that club, providing that not more than two of those boats shall sail in the same event.

The trophies will be awarded according to the points scored for the week by the club's best three nominated boats. In the event of a tie, points for the best discard shall count.

## 14. Protests: [amending RRS 61.1(a)]

No yacht shall be obliged to fly a protest flag even if the length of her hull shall exceed 6 metres.

## 15. Valuables:

Visitors are requested not to leave valuables in the changing rooms.

## 16. Boat Parking, Car Parking, Accommodation & Camping:

All competitors are requested to park boats and cars with due care, complying with attendants guidance and ensuring that vehicles do not obstruct the main causeway, or access to / egress from the Club for emergency, contractors, & delivery vehicles. Any vehicle causing an obstruction will be removed by force.

**Absolutely no camping, camper vans or sleeping on H.I.S.C. site overnight other than in official club accommodation. Failure to observe this may lead to action under Clause 1.2 Good Behaviour.**
