Dear Competitor

Hayling Island Sailing Club is looking forward to hosting the 2021 RS Feva National Championships and on behalf of all Hayling Island Sailing Club members, we would like to welcome families, friends, and, most importantly, the competitors of the 2021 RS Feva National Championships.

We have spent many months making every effort to ensure that HISC is ready for this event and are now keeping our fingers crossed that the weather gods play their part in putting on some great conditions for you all!

We have some important information regarding the event so please make sure you read the following information prior to your arrival.

We are still operating under strict Covid restrictions and have plans in place to make sure the event is run safely for everyone onsite. It is very important everyone follows our guidelines and rules at all times. If one of our Covid Marshalls or members of staff asks you to follow a specific instruction please do so, and if you have any questions, they will be happy to help you so please ask.

NHS Covid-19 Test and Trace App - everyone who comes to the club MUST scan the QR code each day. These can be found around the club, on the front door, as you enter the toilet/changing rooms and on the windows around the balcony.

Arrival Instructions and car / boat parking

Thank you to everyone who has provided us with a vehicle registration number. If you have not yet done so, there is still time. This will allow easy access through the barrier. We will issue you with a car sticker at registration which must be displayed in your windscreen at all times. This will also allow you entry through the main gate.

- Car parking will be along the causeway and in the overflow car park. The overflow carpark has to be locked every night at 10pm. Any vehicle left in there after this time will not be able to leave until 8am the following day. If you think you will be leaving the club later than 10pm please arrange to move your vehicle to another parking space before this time.
- Road trailers need to be parked in the overflow car park.
- The boat park will be in the main car park. We would also like members to park their Feva's in this area.
- Pre-registered support RIBS will be launched by the Marine department, once launched you will be allocated a mooring for the event. Multiple RIBS will have to share a small number of moorings. The Marine Team and Ferry Driver will direct you to the right mooring.

If you are bringing your boat to the club on Friday please park in the area marked "Boat Park". Road trailers will need to be parked in the overflow car park on Saturday morning, but can remain in the car park adjacent to the barrier on the Friday night.

There will be people on hand to guide you in the right direction.

Registration and Sailing Information

Registration is from 0800 until 1100 on Saturday. Please complete all forms online prior to your arrival. There will not be any forms available to complete at registration. We will issue you with the following:

- Flight Ribbons
- Visitor Harbour Dues
- Daily Pasta and Championship meal ticket (sailors please collect your pasta from the Beach Bar as soon as you come ashore)
- Any prepaid dinner tickets
- Car Park sticker

- The Sailing Instructions have now been published
- The Entry list with Tally numbers and flight allocations will be published on Friday.
- Competitor briefing information will be published prior to the event. To avoid large gatherings there will not be briefing. The Race officer will update the sailors with any specific information over the tannoy
- Prize winners will be announced over the tannoy and will be invited to collect their prizes from the training room

Changing Rooms will be open and the code to enter the back door is 0521# - however, government advice is to actively discourage you from using them as they are a high-risk area for the transmission of Covid. We therefore recommend you shower and change at home, where possible. If you do decide to use them, be as quick as you can and limit the number in the changing room to six at a time (under 16's to be supervised from a location nearby). No belongings or sailing bags are to be kept in the changing rooms whilst you are out sailing. The outside showers now run with warm water and this provides an alternative solution with less risk attached.

Dinner will be available daily from 1700 – 2100 and served from the dining room servery with access via the balcony. Strict Covid social distancing measures must be maintained as this will be a collect and go process. Social distancing, use of hand sanitiser and tables of no more than six will be required. Please have your meal ticket available and follow the route indicated by our crew and volunteers.

First Aiders are on duty at the club from 0800 to 1800. Please ask at Reception. Outside this time a first aid box is available from the Bar and the duty manager will be able to assist.

Wireless internet is available throughout the clubhouse. The password is HISC2016.
