Key Timings

- 1. Registration: 09:15 -10:45 in the Training Room outside Reception.
- 2. Competitor Briefing: 10:30 in the Main Bar
- 3. Est Start times (subject to weather and "stuff")

a.	11:00	SUP, Prone
b.	11:10	Windsurfer (All Windsurf CATS)
c.	11:20	Wing Foil
d.	11:30	OC1, OC2 & KAYAK
e.	11:30	OC6 and Gigs

- 4. Après Surf, as soon as you finish, collect your finishers medal, have a shower, enjoy your post-race meal and join us in the Main Bar/Balcony for some music and relaxation.
- 5. Prizegiving, as soon as we can!

Arrival and Registration and Breakfast

HISC is at Sandy Point Hayling Island, Hayling Island, PO11 9 SL. On arrival, drive through the entrance and onto the causeway which leads to the club. Parking is in the main car park or on the causeway itself.

Registration will be in the Training Rooms at the entrance to the club house - this is from **09:15 to 10:45**, here you will collect your tracker and safety bib.

For those wanting breakfast, teas and coffee, these will be available from 08:00 to 10:00 in the upstairs Dining Room. <u>Click Here</u> to see our floor plans.

During the day our "Beach Bar" will be open serving baguettes, hot food etc – this is at the back of the club on the ground floor.

Barista coffee is sold in the upstairs Lounge Bar and Main Bar.

The Challenge Key Timings & Safety

The anticipated start times are: (please note these could change depending on weather etc)

a.	11:00	SUP, Prone
b.	11:10	Windsufer (All Windsurf CATS)
c.	11:20	Wing Foil
d.	11:30	OC1, OC2 & KAYAK
e.	11:30	OC6 and Gigs

The start sequence for each race start will be

•	3 minutes to start	Horn – Red Flag raised
•	2 minutes to start	Horn - Red flag down – Yellow flag raised
•	1 minutes to start	Horn – Yellow flag down – Green flag raised
•	Start	Horn - Green flag will be lowered.

All competitors must wear the safety bib given at registration, this must be worn outside your life jacket and carry the electronic tracker - for 2 man and above there will be one tracker per craft.

Courses

There are two options:

- "Round Hayling" a full circumnavigation of the island
- "Bridge and Back" shorter course (approx. 7 miles)

Safety instructions will be given at the briefing so please make sure you attend.

- On Arrival tell the Gateman you are here for the Round Hayling Challenge
- Use the following access code to get past the security barrier: **#1980** the # <u>must</u> be in front of the number to work.
- If you need space to rig and/or unload your sails/boards/boats, there is space in the designated area.
- Park your car in the carpark areas.
