Ageing and ill health reluctantly force her sale. She is currently moored at Hayling Island sailing Club. She is Lloyds registered at Portsmouth.

Beta 28, 3 cylinder diesel engine with reduction gearbox, regularly serviced and maintained. Three bladed propeller with rope cutter.

5 year old stainless steel fuel tank under cockpit floor.

Primary fuel filter and traditional stuffing box

Hull professionally peeled and epoxied 2015

Procter B mast. Boom rigged with in boom mainsail stowage and two levels of full length batten reefing, lazy jacks. Single line reefing.
