## Accommodation at HISC

Accommodation is available to Club members, their guests and people attending official Club events. It is basic accommodation and located in two blocks, Stocker and Dunes, both situated near the clubhouse.

The **Stocker** block comprises ten two-bed bunk rooms and six four-bed bunk rooms. In addition, there are four double-bedded rooms, two of which are en suite. The **Dunes** block comprises ten identical mezzanine style rooms, each one sleeping up to 3 adults or two adults and two children.

Bedding is supplied in all rooms but guests need to bring their own towels.

Demand for accommodation is high when sailing events are taking place, so please book early to avoid disappointment.

### Stocker Accommodation

#### Bunk-bed rooms:

Very basic accommodation - sleeping either 2 or 4.

£23.00/£40.00 (Oct–April) and £28.00/£45.00 (May–Sept).

*There are no electrical points in the bunk rooms.*

#### Double-bedded Rooms:

Double-bedded – shared shower and toilet facilities:

##### Captain's Cabin x 2:

These are our upgraded double-bedded rooms with sinks, storage space and tea and coffee making facilities - a cosy and comfy environment.

£34.00 per night (Oct–April) and £39.00 per night (May–Sept)

Toilets are located on the ground floor and first floor. Showers are located on ground floor only.

##### Double-bedded en suite:

##### Admiral's (disabled) and Commodore's Cabin:

These two rooms are our upgraded double-bedded rooms with en suite shower rooms, storage space and tea and coffee making facilities - a cosy and comfy environment.

Admirals: £34.00 per night (Oct–April) and £39.00 per night (May–Sept)

Commodore's: £45.00 per night (Oct–April) and £50.00 per night (May–Sept)



### Dunes Accommodation

These are ten mezzanine style rooms with two single beds and a small double bed on the mezzanine level, plus an ensuite shower room.

Maximum recommended occupancy, three adults or two adults and two children.

## FAQ by new members

### **How long does it take to become a member of HISC?**

Not long, but to become a member of HISC you should attend a 'New Members Briefing'. On receipt of your application form, the Club will write to/email you confirming the upcoming briefing dates. If you are unable to attend any of these dates, please contact the membership secretary to arrange a more suitable time.

### **What are the costs of joining HISC?**

To become a member of HISC there are two separate fees which are; a one off entrance fee (where applicable), and annual subscription.

In addition, if you wish to sail a boat at HISC, there is a boat registration fee, and a boat parking fee (if you are allocated a space in the dinghy park).

### **What do I pay the day I join HISC as a member?**

You will pay the whole entrance fee (where applicable), subscription and boat registration/parking fees.

### **Can these payments be made by Direct Debit?**

Your entrance fee on joining the Club must be paid in full, by card/cash or cheque together with your 1<sup>st</sup> month's subscription. Thereafter, your subscription will be paid by Direct Debit. You will be asked to complete a Direct Debit mandate form when you join.

### **What stipulates a family?**

Family membership is not just for people who are married with children but is also open to partners who share the same address. Children (and grandchildren) under the age of 18 are included in this membership.

### **Do you offer a temporary membership?**

Yes, if you would like to sail from the Club and use the facilities, you can pay a day sailing fee which is £13.50 - £25.00, depending on the type of boat you are launching. Advance booking is required. If you would like to visit the Club without a boat, please contact the Membership Secretary prior to your visit.

### **What is the difference between dinghy registration only and registration & parking?**

If you would like to sail your dinghy from the Club it will need to be registered. We currently offer 2 types of registration these are;

**Registration only;** this type of registration allows the dinghy to be sailed from the Club but does not include an allocated boat parking space. You may however leave the dinghy overnight when sailing on consecutive days at the weekend if permission has been granted by the Marine Manager.

**Registration & Parking;** this enables you to keep your dinghy at the Club in its own allocated bay. Due to limited space in the dinghy park, any member (new or existing) wishing to bring a dinghy to the Club, will be added to the waiting list and must await confirmation from the Marine Manager that a space is available.

**I want to join HISC to support my child sailing but do not sail myself, what is there for me?**

Apart from the fantastic setting of HISC, with its private sandy beaches, HISC also boasts a very active all year round social programme; which include our Summer ball, Christmas parties for adults & children and New Year's Eve party to mention a few. The Club also hosts wine tasting evenings, live music, Thai nights and after-dinner talks. Members can also book functions at the Club for private events. There are also plenty of opportunities for members to become involved in running the Club and helping to organise and support events ashore and afloat.

**I am not a member but my child who is under 18 wishes to become a Youth member at HISC, is this possible?**

We do like a parent to join HISC to support their children. However we understand that families often have other commitments and therefore we have a Youth membership available for those age 16 or 17 who can join for the year without their parents becoming members.

**We hope you will understand that where parents do not become members they have no entitlement to stay on site when their children are at the Club.**

The Club cannot offer membership to any child under 16, but Winter Youth membership is available for those wishing to join the Club temporarily for winter training. This is available for children age 8 -17, from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> March. This membership category allows children to take part in the autumn/winter Club Class training. Parents are included on this membership in a non-sailing role and would be expected to help run the training. Parents would only be able to use the Club while accompanying their child during training events, but at least one parent is expected to be on site when their children are under the age of 16 are at the Club.
