## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Changing rule J1.2 (1), any changes to the racing rules will be stated in the sailing instructions.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The race is open to all windsurfers. The entry limit is 150 competitors in total (windsurf and stand up paddleboard).
- 2.2 Eligible windsurfers must enter online at [www.hisc.co.uk](http://www.hisc.co.uk). Online entry will open on Sun 7th March 2010 and will close on Wednesday 31st March 2010.
- 2.3 **Parent/Guardian Declarations:** All windsurfers under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either by post or at registration.

### 3 FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee £25 for entry prior to Wednesday 24th March
- 3.2 Entry fee £30 for entry from Wednesday 24th March – 31st March 2010

### 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: Friday 2nd April from 8.30am
- 4.2 Dates of racing: Friday 2nd April. Start 12.00pm
- 4.3 Number of races: 1
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 11.55am

### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and on the website.

### 6 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 6.1 Sailors will be required to sail through two gates on the course. One will be positioned in the area of Northney Marina and the other near the Ferryboat Inn on the west side of Hayling Island. Failure to pass through these gates will result in disqualification

## **7 SCORING**

7.1 Gold course. A sailor's score and position will be recorded on return to the beach at HISC. Sailors will be required to touch a flag where their position will be recorded.

Silver course. On closure of the second gate sailors' positions will be recorded on the shore by the Ferryboat Inn. Sailors will be required to touch a flag on the shore where their position will be recorded.

Bronze course. Sailors who chose to sail to the first gate and return to HISC shores will have their positions recorded on the shore when they touch the flag.

7.2 There will be three courses; Gold course, Full circumnavigation of the island  
Silver course, Reaching the second gate of the course  
Bronze course Reaching the first gate and returning to the HISC shore.

## **8 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall register at the Race Office during the registration period.

## **9 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> for full completion of the course  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> for completion of silver course  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> for completion of the bronze course

## **10 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & LIKENESSES**

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

## **11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat and its helm and crew are fit to sail in the conditions that they might find. By launching or going to sea competitors confirm their boat is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organizers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organizers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organizers encompass everyone helping to run the event and include the organizing authority, race committee, race officer, safety officer, patrol boat personnel and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.

## **12 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2million per event or the equivalent.

**Camper Vans at HISC:**
