

Would saving **£5,000** a year convince you to drive electric?

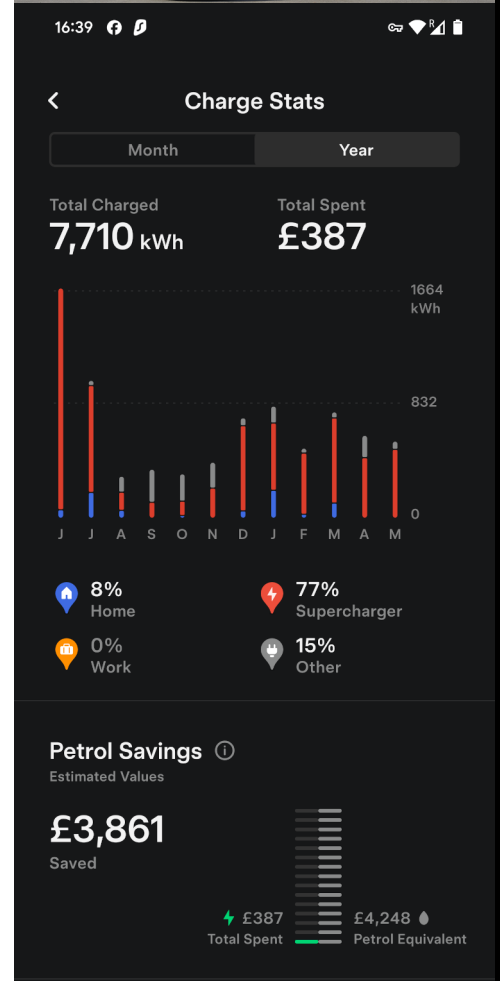
In February 2019 John & Michelle took the bold step of spending £60K on a three year old early Tesla Model S electric car with 30,000 miles on the clock.

Six years on their nine year old car has done 95,000 miles, has crossed bridges without them collapsing, has been parked & charged up without catching fire and is still on the same battery. Not only that, they claim that it saves them around £5,000 a year!
